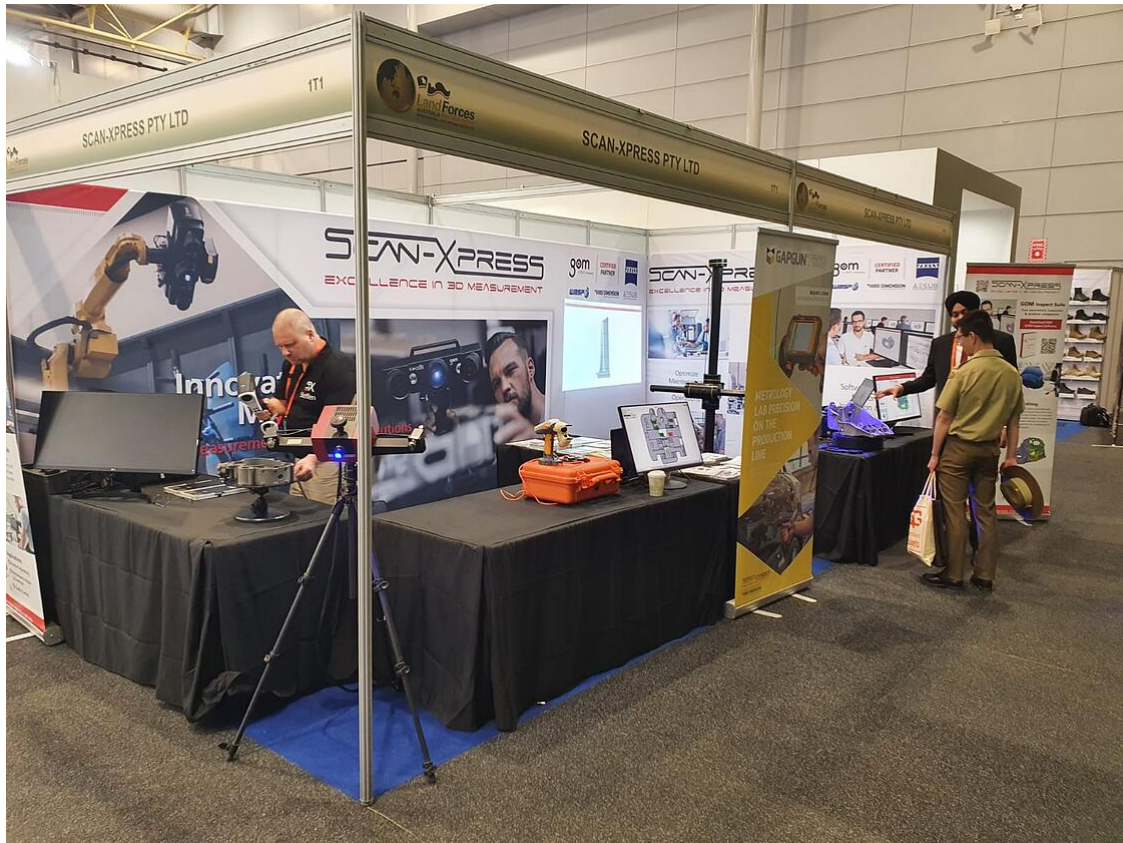

Move to new Brunswick location

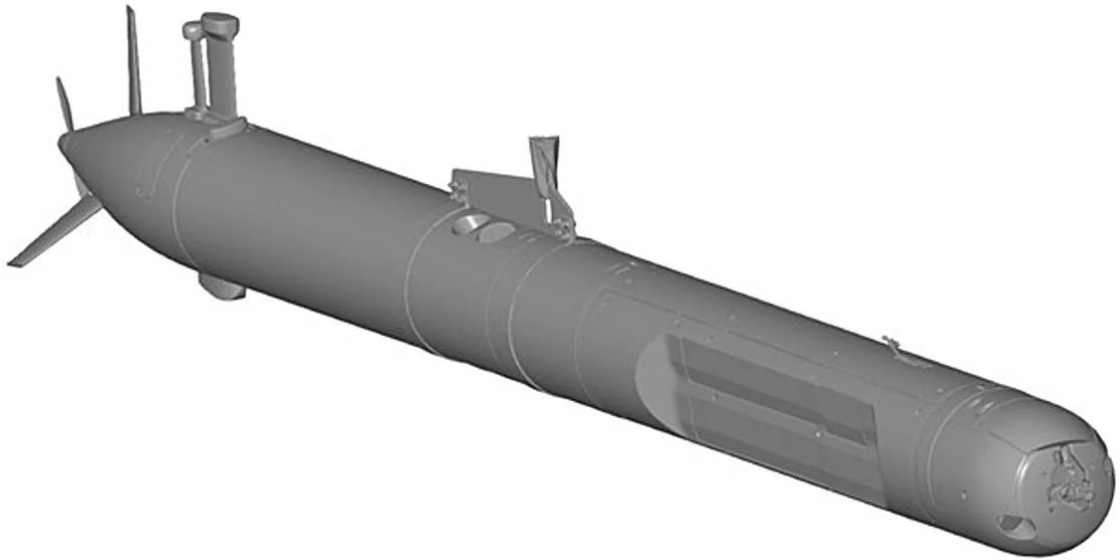
